Epidemiologist: Epidemiologists investigate the patterns and causes of diseases and other health-related problems. They also design and implement <u>public health interventions to prevent the spread of disease</u>.

Health Policy Analyst: Health policy analysts work to develop, implement, and evaluate public health policies at the local, state, and federal levels.

Public Health Educator: Public health educators create and implement programs to promote healthy behaviors and prevent disease.



Biostatistician: Biostatisticians design and analyze clinical trials and other research studies to evaluate the safety and efficacy of drugs, medical devices, and other healthcare interventions.

Environmental Health Specialist: Environmental health specialists work to identify and mitigate environmental factors that can impact human health, such as pollution and toxic substances.

Health Services Manager: Health services managers oversee the operations of healthcare facilities, including hospitals, clinics, and public health agencies.

Global Health Specialist: <u>Global health specialists</u> work to improve the health of people in developing countries by implementing public health programs and initiatives.

Health Communication Specialist: Health communication specialists create and disseminate health-related information to the public, including health promotion materials, media campaigns, and educational programs.
